Please join us at Sacramento's annual August Peace Event to commemorate the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the tragic bombings of Nagasaki and Hiroshima and to renew our dedication to the abolition of nuclear weapons. We will come together on Sunday, August 2, 2015, from 3-4:30pm in the Social Hall at St John's Lutheran Church, 1701 L St., Sacramento.

Our speaker this year is Andrew Lichterman, lawyer and senior policy analyst with Oakland based Western States Legal Foundation (WSLF), who will speak on "Nuclear Weapons and the Dangers of Great Power Wars Today." Lichterman is a member of the Global Council of the Abolition 2000 Global Network to Eliminate Nuclear Weapons. For 30 years, WSLF has been a major force in the movement to abolish nuclear weapons.

The planning committee has prepared an inspirational family program with music by Chanteuses, who for nearly 20 years have been entertaining Sacramento with their superb blend of vocal harmonies. We will also tell the story of *Sadako and the Thousand Cranes*, and there will be an opportunity to take action against nuclear weapons.

We anticipate a meaningful afternoon and hope that you and your family and friends can join us. Doors open at 2:45pm for refreshments, networking and the chance to view our sponsors' tables. There is plenty of free street parking or use the free church parking lot with an entrance on K street. We are reserving the church lot for handicapped parking.

This issue is more important than ever, as the U.S. continues to spend billions to "modernize" its nuclear arsenal and as tensions grow between the U.S. and Russia. The U.S. and other nations still commit vast amounts of resources to weapons development, because of the hypocrisy of nuclear nations trying to prevent their perceived enemies from having nukes, while overlooking weapons developed by their allies.
